Volunteer Placement

We are looking for volunteers who can support staff at our Rough Sleeper Enablement Centre or befriend people in accommodation.

Placements are available to people who:

- Successfully complete either the 2-day or 8-week volunteer course.
- Are able to commit to 6 months and 5 hours minimum (2 hours for befriending) each week.
- Provide satisfactory references. We also undertake our own CRB check—and we risk assess each volunteer on a case by case basis, so what's happened in the past won't necessarily affect your placement!

We know you've got the life-skills to befriend and support others, but do you have the confidence? Our pre-volunteer courses last for 8 weeks and will give you the boost you need to start volunteer training. We offer a range of activities including art & craft, trips out, discussion groups and lots more. The activity programme runs twice weekly on Mondays and Fridays from 1-3pm. It's a chance to meet like-minded people, get back into a routine, and **HAVE SOME FUN!!** By the end of the course you should be ready to take the next step to becoming a volunteer—either at The Whitechapel Centre or somewhere else. The pre-volunteer course is specifically aimed at people who are homeless, in housing need or are socially excluded.

8 Week Volunteer Course

High quality support and training to enable homeless/socially excluded people to become skilled volunteers. The training programme will run every Wednesday 12pm to 4pm for 8 weeks.

Potential volunteers are asked to complete an application form and successfully pass an informal interview prior to starting training.



2 Day Intensive Volunteer Course

Aimed at people who are able to demonstrate a high level of skills, knowledge and/or experience which means that intensive 2 day training will adequately prepare them for a volunteer role. This may include:

- Previous paid/voluntary experience
- Life experience
- Academic skills
- Specific skills (e.g foreign language skills)

Potential volunteers are asked to complete an application form and successfully pass an informal interview prior to starting training.
